

Associate Supervisor

The Baltimore County Soil Conservation District is seeking residents of Baltimore County who have an interest in the District's mission of promoting practical and effective soil, water and related natural resource conservation programs to all citizens in a timely fashion on a voluntary basis. Main duties include contributing time, knowledge and experience helpful in developing and implementing the District's soil conservation and water quality programs. Associate Supervisors do not have voting power like elected and appointed Supervisors do, however their input is helpful to those with authority. Very often Associate Supervisors will go on to be Elected or Appointed Supervisors. Associate Supervisors are appointed to a one-year term of office and shall attend a minimum of five (5) Board meetings a year.
